

## 2026 RATE SHEET

### IN-HOUSE LABOR

Hourly Rates shown are for Regular Business Hours 7:30 - 16:00 Monday - Friday. Overtime billed at time and a half. Sundays and Observed Holidays billed at double time. Four (4) hour minimum on Saturdays and Sundays.  
There is no sales tax on labor in the state of Georgia. Sales tax on materials is included in quoted paint prices.

### YARD SERVICES

Includes water, project management, administrative services, gate security, non-regulated garbage collection, one boarding ladder, crew lounge, office space as available. Daily Rate will be charged for every day vessel is in the yard.

OFF PEAK (JAN-AUG)	\$1.50/ft/day in water and hard standing space	\$3.50/ft/day in building

Larger projects including tent enclosures will be charged for the footprint of the project.

Extended Dockage in service basin after completion of work and/or Conditional Live-aboard on hard standing or in service building will be charged an additional \$1/ft/day. Vessel initiated lay days may be assessed at Double Daily Rate.

### SHORE POWER

Hookup and disconnect at standard shore connection.\* Includes 50 ft of protective sleeve for vessel's cord. \$475

\*Any modifications or additional equipment required will be charged in addition to standard connection T&M \$90/hr.

TMI Rotary Converter if available, \$175 daily plus daily rate per cord. Outside rental generators and converters available by arrangement. Delivery, setup and other charges will apply.

Blocking \$80/hr. Vessel haulout or lifting plan is required of all vessels for Travelift and Syncrolift haulout.

TMI Syncrolift blocking plan based on vessel furnished docking plan, stability booklet & structural drawings is required.

<b>FOREIGN WASTE</b>	Foreign Waste Collection & Disposal is compulsory per government regulations for foreign arrivals. See CBP Maritime Regulated Garbage Guidelines. Please advise your project manager or TMI contact prior to arrival. Price is per mobilization.	
<b>OUTSIDE CONTRACTORS</b>	Thunderbolt Marine is a repair and refit facility with restricted entry. In addition to the rates listed for in-house labor, licensed and insured Outside Contractors are welcome. A fee will be charged for all contractors working on vessels in TMI facility. 5% for main engine and generator service. 15% when contracting directly with vessel. 25% when contracting through TMI. \$60 head fee for work done under Outside Contractor Warranty*. All Outside Contractor Billing will go through Thunderbolt Marine. Outside Contractors must provide proof of insurance and have signed agreement on file prior to arrival to work. We require detailed work lists from all vessels prior to arrival in order to allocate resources accordingly.
